- 1. Originality: Does the paper contain new and significant information adequate to justify publication?: Yes, but the underlisted recommendations should be incorporated first.
- 2. Relationship to Literature: Does the paper demonstrate an adequate understanding of the relevant literature in the field and cite an appropriate range of literature sources? Is any significant work ignored?: ok
- 3. Methodology: Is the paper's argument built on an appropriate base of theory, concepts or other ideas? Has the research or equivalent intellectual work on which the paper is based been well designed? Are the methods employed appropriate?: The methodology adopted is ok, but the following should be considered.
- 1. The author states that all the listed companies in Indonesia were considered in the selection of the study sample but failed to state the number of listed companies on the stock market.
- 2. There is the need to explain the acronyms used in the econometric model.
- 3 There is the need to state clearly the independent and control variables used in the study,
- 4. Results: Are results presented clearly and analysed appropriately? Do the conclusions adequately tie together the other elements of the paper?: The results are clearly presented and compared with the literature reviewed.
- 5. Implications for research, practice and/or society: Does the paper identify clearly any implications for research, practice and/or society? Does the paper bridge the gap between theory and practice? How can the research be used in practice (economic and commercial impact), in teaching, to influence public policy, in research (contributing to the body of knowledge)? What is the impact upon society (influencing public attitudes, affecting quality of life)? Are these implications consistent with the findings and conclusions of the paper?: Ok.
- 6. Quality of Communication: Does the paper clearly express its case, measured against the technical language of the fields and the expected knowledge of the journal's readership? Has attention been paid to the clarity of expression and readability, such as sentence structure, jargon use, acronyms, etc.: The paper can benefit from further proof reading to correct some minor grammatical errors.

Reviewer: 2

Recommendation: Major Revision

Comments:

I hope that the comments help you improve the paper. I suggest to rethink the contribution of the paper and explain why it is important to examine the institutional ownership characteristics.

Additional Questions:

1. Originality: Does the paper contain new and significant information adequate to justify publication?: The authors fail to convince the reader on the contribution of their study. Reading the introduction, I see that it is important to examine the impact of institutional ownership (Instit. Own) on environnemental disclosore but I'm not convinced why it is important to examine the identity charcateristics of these owners. and why authors choose these specific characteristics and not others.

The abstract should be modified. It is unclear.

- 2. Relationship to Literature: Does the paper demonstrate an adequate understanding of the relevant literature in the field and cite an appropriate range of literature sources? Is any significant work ignored?: The litterature review is adequate.
- 3. Methodology: Is the paper's argument built on an appropriate base of theory, concepts or other ideas? Has the research or equivalent intellectual work on which the paper is based been well designed? Are the methods employed appropriate?: I'm not convinced that agency and stakeholder theories are the best to developp the various hypotheses. Why the authors do not use legitimacy theory?

hypotheses development is weak. For example, H1 is not well argued. Why the authors do not develop the hypothess based also on the percentage hold?

4. Results: Are results presented clearly and analysed appropriately? Do the conclusions adequately tie together the other elements of the paper?: The methodology and results are clear in general.

The authors should include a table of variable description.

More information are needed for the variable description in section 5.1.

Why and who use GRI? why its is suitable for your study?

- 5. Implications for research, practice and/or society: Does the paper identify clearly any implications for research, practice and/or society? Does the paper bridge the gap between theory and practice? How can the research be used in practice (economic and commercial impact), in teaching, to influence public policy, in research (contributing to the body of knowledge)? What is the impact upon society (influencing public attitudes, affecting quality of life)? Are these implications consistent with the findings and conclusions of the paper?: This part of the paper is weak. There is no discussion on the practical or society implications of the paper.
- 6. Quality of Communication: Does the paper clearly express its case, measured against the technical language of the fields and the expected knowledge of the journal's readership? Has attention been paid to the clarity of expression and readability, such as sentence structure, jargon use, acronyms, etc.: In different places there are several repetition of ideas.
